INFORMATION

CLAY is a gathering of youth from across Canada. It takes place every two years in locations across the country. Our gathering in 2018 will take place in Thunder Bay, Ontario from August 15-19. Check out claygathering.ca for more information.

This year the theme for CLAY is "Threads". We will gather from across Canada and learn how to discern our God-given stories. We will discover how God weaves our stories together to form the tapestry of our lives. These stories can be ancient, personal, intimate, and can help us find meaning and purpose. We will gather stories from each other and from our surroundings.

At CLAY youth will encounter scripture in meaningful ways, experience ancient and modern forms of worship, learn together, enjoy fantastic social events, explore Thunder Bay, and make connections with youth from across Canada!

Who can come to CLAY?

Clay is designed for youth participants who will be 14-19 in 2018 (born between 1999 and 2004). Consideration will be given to youth who are 13 (born in 2005).

Costs per Participant?

Total cost per participant is budgeted at \$1700:
\$700 - flight
\$600 - CLAY registration & accommodation
\$400 ground travel, accommodation, food & activities

How will costs be covered?

\$600 - Participant
(\$300 - participant contribution due March 1 / \$300 - personal fundraising efforts due May 31)
\$300 - Parish Contribution
\$300 - Diocesan Contribution
\$500 - Group Fundraising (per person)

Participants MUST participate in group fundraising!
(this could include: parish pancake suppers, bake sales, bottle drives, chocolate sales, silent auctions, talent auctions, spaghetti nights, car washes, ... we will get creative!)
