Christ Church Cathedral: Financial Update

The finance committee met this week and reviewed the parish financial statements from Jan.1 to Sept. 30, 2018. Here is a summary of our current situation. Although overall revenues are lower than budget, operating donations pretty well match budget and are higher than the prior year. Revenues are somewhat less than budget in other areas which includes special initiatives due to timing of planned events, and investment returns due to market value losses in the last 2 months (we are still awaiting known bequests we have been advised of for the year). Expenses are now less than budget in a few areas. Payroll costs are down as we had budgeted for a four month overlap with the new vicar, which is not taking place. \ Parish program costs are decreased mainly as refugee expenses have been delayed due to the late arrival of the refugees. We had the opportunity to boost our Victoria Foundation Endowment Fund by another \$5,000 as our contribution of \$2,500 was matched 100% by another donor through the foundation. We continue to thank those to give regular offerings and special gifts. Your continuing donations towards the Cathedral are always gratefully appreciated.
